Description: The Salish Sea School, in collaboration with GEAR UP, is seeking to hire two mentors from June 24-28, 2024.

Guardianes del Mar is a five-day boat and island-based program designed to spark interest in marine ecosystems and highlight the connections between water quality, marine life, and human impacts.

Students will participate in hands-on learning experiences, sea adventures, and field investigations to deepen their knowledge and appreciation for the Salish Sea's unique habitats and the species that inhabit them.

This week-long summer program was designed to provide a cohort of 30 rising Latinx 8th-grade students in the Skagit Valley with the opportunity to learn about and study the Salish Sea.

Mentors will help support students in and around the Salish Sea onsite in Anacortes.

Mentors will be supported and supervised by staff from The Salish Sea School and GEAR UP school district staff.

One day of two hours of virtual training at least one week before the program will be required.

Bilingual in Spanish, Mixteco or Triqui Lived experience with students and families from the Skagit Valley Understanding of the challenges faced by first-generation college students Majors in Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math (STEM) and/or experience and expertise in STEM fields

Establish a connection with mentees Attend all mandatory mentor meetings/trainings Must be available for the entire duration of the program Ability to mentor small groups of mentees (4-6) Assist mentees in making cultural connections Coordinate and facilitate group activities with other mentors Act as a role-model

NOTE: Virtual training is required. Lunch during the field experience portion of the program will be provided to mentors. Bus transportation from Burlington-Edison High School to Anacortes will also be provided to mentors.
