skip the single-use plastic straw during your next restaurant visit	pick up 5 pieces of trash	draw a picture of the endangered Southern Resident orcas	look up 2 facts about the endangered Southern Resident orcas	eat sustainably sourced salmon (ask a restaurant where they get it from if you don't know)
purchase a bamboo toothbrush	look up the difference between a Bigg's orca's diet and a Southern Resident orca's diet	pick up 10 pieces of trash on a beach	turn the water off when you brush your teeth	teach 3 friends about 1 thing they can do to help orcas
look up 2 facts about Bigg's orcas	write a haiku or poem about orcas	turn off your lights when you leave a room!	tune into the "Orca Sound" hydrophone (underwater microphone) every so often (www.orcasound.net/)	pick up after your dog
wash out your recyclables before putting them in the recycling bin	use reusable Tupperware or silicone bags instead of Ziploc bags	look up 2 facts about the Salish Sea	bring your own Tupperware to a restaurant to bring home your leftovers	bike/walk instead of driving
